Please stop by and check them out. Their food is excellent!!!! The ambiance is excellent!!!! And their friendly welcome will make you want to come back.

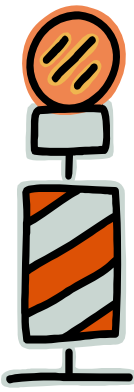

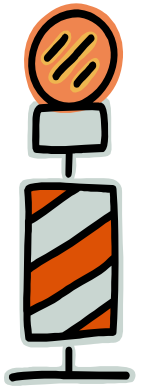

They have a complete full service Natural Pharmacy with Chinese herbal medicines and custom make powdered formulas for patients. They also provided Western herbal medicines, Homeopathic medicines from GUNA & HEEL. They also provide vitamins and supplements for patients from PURE. All of our medicines are by RX only. They only carry medicine that is only available to physicians to prescribe for patients. Our medicine is not found over the counter.

They also provide injections and injection therapy including Mesotherapy and Lippodisolve. They inject vitamins and homeopathic all approved as injectables by the FDA and only available by physicians. They also offer Acupuncture & Oriental Medicine services including medical Qi Gong, Moxabustion, Laser, Electro, Cosmetic, Auricular and Neurological Acupuncture. They also offer food therapy which is based on Oriental Medicine approach to diet. They use acupuncture needles approved by the FDA. They also treat most acute and chronic conditions and can order lab work and imaging services. They currently use Lab Corp for all lab work ordered. Acupuncturists in Florida are considered Acupuncture Physicians & Doctors of Oriental Medicine and are licensed as primary care providers. Primary Care in Oriental Medicine should not take the place of traditional care from a MD/DO but should be used as complementary. New patient visits last anywhere from 1 1/2 hours to 2 hours and a complete physician examination is performed.



CONSTRUCTION ON SOUTH 2ND STREET BEGINS THE WEEK OF JULY 12TH



The work will involve the complete reconstruction of the streets, sidewalks, etc. along S. 2nd Street (between S. Daytona Ave. and Ocean Shore Blvd.) and S. Daytona Ave (between Moody Blvd. and S. 2nd St.) :

S. 2nd St. will be closed to vehicle traffic during the duration of the work. The S. Daytona Ave. work will only require that street to be partially closed on a temporary basis. Pedestrian access to the effected properties will be maintained at all times. New Large Redevelopment Project Announced

The Golden Lion Café has announced that it is preparing to expand its service area for its customers. Plans include a three phased approach to the overall project which will be completed in 12 months time.

They plan to cover the seating on the South Side of the current Restaurant and then build an additional deck with a seating area above it. Finally, they will be building a free standing Tiki Bar and Gardens.

The CRA will contribute \$10,000 to the project which will involve an over \$100,000 investment on the part of the owners. The Golden Lion Café has been in business here in Flagler Beach for over 18 years and is the most awarded restaurant in Flagler County.
