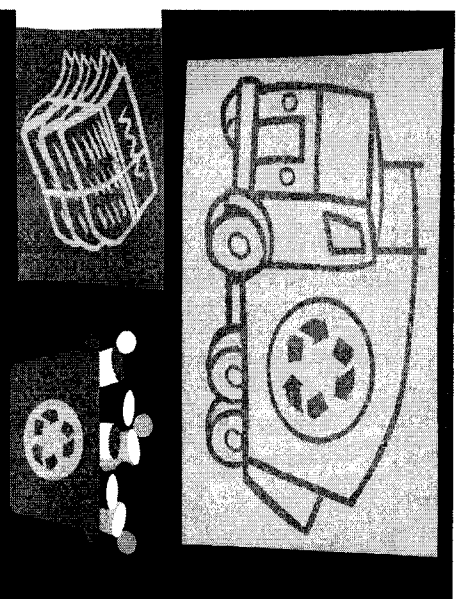

Items that do not belong in your recycle bin:

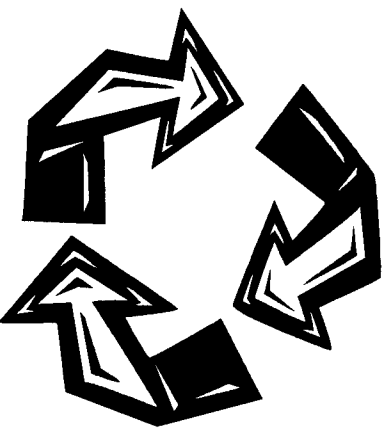
- Plate Glass

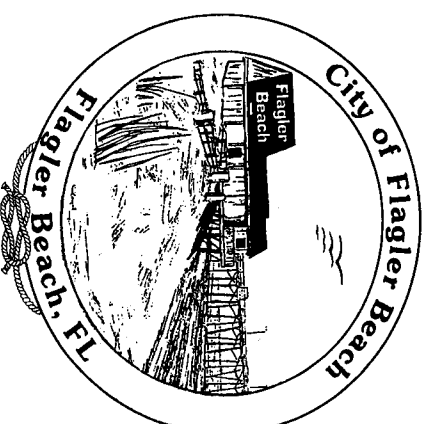

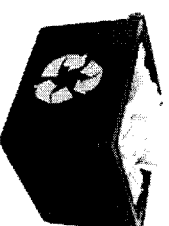

### FLAGLER BEACH RECYCLES

The following is a list of all materials that are collected curbside.

- Steel (tin) Cans
- Aluminum Cans
- Glass
- Plastic with a 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 on the bottom
- Newspapers
- Cardboard
- Magazines
- Phone Books
- Plastic Bags
- Shredded Paper





Dear Flagler Beach Residents:

We sincerely wish to provide you with the best sanitation service at the least possible cost to you. To accomplish this goal, we ask that you help us help you by separating your recyclables from your garbage.

Q HOW DOES SEPARATING RECYCLABLES SAVE OUR CITY MONEY?

A. The City pays dumping fees based on the total weight of the garbage (solid waste) collected. This is known as “tipping fees” which is the charge (per ton of waste) for tipping the trucks at the disposal site. Removing the recyclable material lowers the City’s cost to dispose of our solid waste.

Q. IS RECYCLING REQUIRED BY LAW?

A. Yes. City Ordinance 2008-03 requires separation of garbage and recycling.

Q. HOW CAN I COMPLY WITH THE RECYCLING LAW?

A. By separating recyclable material from garbage and placing it in a trash can that is not larger than 35 gallons or in recyclable bins you can pick up for free at the Flagler County Landfill. You may call (386) 517-2075 for details.

Q. WHERE DO I PLACE THE ITEMS FOR RECYCLING?

A. Place the recycling container in the front of your house next to the curb before 7 A.M.

Wednesday	South of Highway 100 including area South of Snack Jacks
Thursday	North of Highway 100 and West of Intracoastal Waterway, and Golf Course area in South Flagler Beach.

Q. HOW DO I RECYCLE HAZARDOUS WASTE?

A. All hazardous waste must be taken to the Flagler County Sanitary Landfill on Old Kings Road. Please call ahead to determine the days and hours of operation and details on what types of materials may be discarded.
